Position: Teaching Associate in Mathematics at the University Laboratory High School at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, a 5-year public high school for 300 select students. Position is a 9-month, renewable position and may be 50% FTE or up to 100% FTE depending on the availability of candidates. Teaching Associate is a non-tenure track faculty appointment at the University of Illinois.

Position: Visiting Teaching Associate in Mathematics at the University Laboratory High School at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, a 5-year public high school for 300 select students. Position is a 9-month visiting position and may be 50% FTE or up to 100% FTE depending on the availability of candidates, the structure of the Uni High Mathematics department and the availability of the position.

Duties: Teach mathematics to academically talented students. Develop innovative curriculum and math education research projects. Present at professional conferences or workshops. Support/coach math teams for math competitions. The position also entails school activities normally required of teachers, such as attendance at faculty meetings, committee work, and non-classroom duties.

Required Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Mathematics, Mathematics Education, or Education (with substantial course work in mathematics), with ability to teach Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Precalculus, and Calculus (including multi-variable).

Desirable Qualifications: Graduate degree in Mathematics or Mathematics Education with graduate math courses. Experience effectively teaching academically talented students. Illinois teaching certificate (secondary mathematics). Evidence of effective and creative secondary teaching experience, evidence of integration of technology into instruction, and experience in developing innovative instructional materials. Knowledge of alternative assessment strategies and non-traditional teaching practices. Experience with (or ability to teach) a Statistics course.

Salary: Commensurate with degree and experience.
