

1. Use the **Quick Search** menu. What is the correct way to enter a **Browse Author** search for Charles Dickens?

- a. Charles Dickens
- b. Dickens, Charles
- c. Either a. or b.
- d. Neither a. nor b.

2. You are looking for books about *movies*. Use the **Quick Search** menu to find the correct Library of Congress subject heading for the term *movies* (hint: use the same strategy we used when looking for cookbooks – follow the *see also* reference).

Questions 3 through 7 refer to the following scenario:

You are doing research on people who have used their influence to spread hostility among people in the United States. Your teacher has recommended a book called *Hatemongers and Demagogues*. In the **Quick Search** menu, do a **Start of Title** search for this book.

3. Which library at the University has this book?

4. What is the book's call number? (Make sure to enter the complete call number.)

5. How many **Library of Congress Subject Headings** does this book have?

6. What subject heading can you click on to find other books about paranoia?

7. Write down the Boolean search strategy for finding another **biography** describing a person or persons who are **either** racist **or** paranoid. Use parentheses and the Boolean operators “and” and “or.” **The terms (“racist,” “paranoid”) must be in the form you see them in # 5.** Otherwise the search will not work properly!

8. Using the **Guided Keyword Search**, look for books on the use of *gas* during *World War I*. Separate your search, putting *gas* in one box and *World War I* in the other. Don't change any of the pull down menu options.

How many books did you get? _____

How many of them actually focus on the use of gas during World War I? _____

By looking at the full record of a book that **IS** on the **general** topic, what Library of Congress subject heading can you click on to find more on-topic books?

How many on-topic books do you get after clicking on this subject heading?

9. Using the **Quick Search** menu, how many books with the Library of Congress Subject Heading *racism* are at the University Library?

10. Click on the subject heading (*racism*) to get to the list of books. Click on *Change Limits* (**not Quick Limit**) and limit your search to books at the Uni High Library. How many books with the Library of Congress Subject Heading *racism* are at the Uni High Library?

11. Using the **Guided Keyword Search** menu, how many books with the **subject word** *racism* are at the Uni High Library?

12. Using the **Guided Keyword Search** menu, how many books with the **subject word** *racism* are at the Undergraduate Library?

Bonus question: Why is there a difference in the number of results between doing a *Browse Subject* search and a *Subject Words* search?
